The Columbus Regional Airport Authority (CRAA), Columbus, OH, is seeking an experienced **Environmental Coordinator** to oversee the CRAA environmental program, including compliance with federal, state and local compliance with environmental regulations at Port Columbus International, Rickenbacker International and Bolton Field Airports. Coordinate written environmental programs including Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), Spill Prevention, Control & Countermeasure Plan (SPCC), and the CRAA environmental Management System (EMS). Coordinate airport activities with the appropriate environmental agencies including USEPA, Ohio EPA, Bureau of Underground Storage Tanks (BUSTR), Air Force Real Property Agency, City of Columbus, US Army Corps of Engineers, and the Ohio Air National Guard. Provides training for environmental topics. Respond to airport environmental emergencies, including hazardous material spills. Coordinate the storage, treatment, disposal, or recycling efforts for airport-related wastes, including hazardous waste. Bachelor's Degree or Associates in Environmental Sciences, Aviation, or equivalent degree preferred. Two (2) years experience in environmental management field. Relevant experience beyond the minimum experience requirement may be substituted for education. Must be available for emergency response to the airports on-call basis. Excellent organizational and communication skills (written and verbal) with the ability to maintain professional, effective working relationships with all levels of the organization, outside consultants and the public. Substantial experience with computers including: Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook. Ability to work in adverse weather conditions. Must possess and maintain a current Ohio Driver's License with good driving record (or obtain within 30 days of employment). Must have regular and predictable attendance. Final offer of employment contingent upon successful completion of 10 year background check, pre-employment physical/drug screen and credit history report.
