In addition, this position works closely with the director on planning initiatives and activities, business planning, and strategy development. This role has an emphasis on airport planning and will directly supervise and lead Operations and Administrative departments.

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Aviation Planning, Aviation or Airport Management, Civil/Transportation Engineering, Aviation Science or Technology, or a related field. Master's degree is preferred.
- Five years of progressively responsible experience in an aviation management position involving either airport planning activities or aviation management including broad based knowledge and experience in providing aviation planning services with minimum three (3) years' experience in professional airport planning activities, aviation planning, design or related experience (public or private).
- Minimum of five years' experience managing and supervising employees with demonstrated leadership success.
- Any equivalent combination of education and/or experience may be substituted for the experience requirement above on a year-for-year basis.
