



# Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority<sup>SM</sup>

## Officer

Under direct supervision, is responsible for the protection of life and property of the general public within the jurisdiction of the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority (MNA).

Officers will be required to successfully complete a basic training program that consists of courses in criminal law, firearms training, physical training, first responder training, traffic law enforcement, human relations, crime scene research, patrol procedures, departmental policies, report writing, and other related areas within a 12-month period. Officers who successfully complete the required training will receive additional on-the-job training thereafter. After required training is completed uncertified Officers will be considered for appointment to Officer I, and certified Officers will be considered for appointment to Officer II.

Must have a comprehensive working knowledge of airport geography and organization, safety and security shift organization and functions, organizational goals and objectives, policy and procedures, applicable federal, state, and local laws and MNA regulations. Responsible for completing a certified Peace Officers Standard and Training (POST) Commission Academy in-service, Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting training and Field Training Officer Program. Must be able to meet and maintain qualifications prescribed by the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission (POST) within 12-months of employment, failure to do so will result in termination of employment.

Uncertified Officer: An associate's degree or comparable degree hours in a relevant field of study from an accredited college OR Certification as a certified Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) in the State of Tennessee or nationally recognized certification OR High school diploma or equivalent with four (4) years of military experience and an honorable discharge.

Certified Officer: High school diploma or equivalent AND Certified by the Peace Officers and Standard Training (POST) Commission on hire date.

**Starting Salary:** \$36,637 (uncertified); \$38,382 (certified)

**Shift:** Must be available to work 1st, 2nd & 3rd shifts. Schedule will include weekdays, weekends & holidays.

**Hiring Bonus:** A one-time bonus of \$3,000 for possessing on hire date a POST or Firefighter I certification, and additional one-time bonus of \$1,800 for possessing on hire date an Emergency Medical Technician certification. Bonus paid upon completion of one year of employment with the Authority.
