

Senior Risk Analyst

Position Summary:

As a Senior Risk Analyst, your role will focus on supporting the execution of the airport's strategic plan by performing professional-level work in the design, development and implementation of DFW's enterprise risk management program. DFW Airport's success and ability to transform travel will depend on utilizing your expertise assessing and mitigating risk, in insurance claims, your ability to communicate important information to necessary parties and follow up afterwards, and your knowledge of implementing, conducting and maintaining safety and training programs. You will work as 1 of 3 Senior Risk Analysts as a resource pool that can be deployed throughout the airport site to address complaints, process claims, conduct site visits, monitor 24/7 Risk hotline on a rotating basis and/or represent Risk Management at the Emergency Operations Center if needed. You will also support the Sr. Managers with project management, including and not limited development of project plans and timelines, evaluating and assessing probability and severity of potential and actual risk exposure and assist with the development and implementation of appropriate action plans.

Performance Objectives:

- Obtain documented evidence of insurance and communicate with appropriate stakeholders regarding noncompliance and corresponding resolution to noncompliance issues. Oversee vendors, contractors and tenants to maintain compliance with contract obligations and ensure adherence to safety standards to prevent accidents.
- Review indemnification language, insurance requirements, certificates of insurance and bonding requirements to perform the contract and vendor risk management analysis.
- Manage the recovery of costs for damage to airport board property, coordinate and monitor claims management activities with appropriate stakeholders, supervise the claim administration of insured claims including conducting site visits and/or investigations with insurance adjusters.
- Analyze incident and claims data to identify trends, develop safety management training

programs, and recommend action plans to reduce or prevent exposure in the future.

- Utilize your expertise and knowledge to train individuals and share best practices to ensure continuous improvement within the department and throughout the organization. Recommend solutions and follow up to ensure closure to the issue.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Insurance, Finance, Accounting, Risk Management or a related field; Master's degree preferred
- Five (5) or more years of experience in risk control (safety, claim) and risk management
- Any equivalent combination of education and/or experience may be substituted for the above
- Possession of a valid Class C driver's license
- Knowledge of multiple lines of insurance and associated case law, Texas Tort Claims Act, basic litigation rules as related to service/timing/customary motions/other standard discovery tools, loss prevention and safety training, indoor air quality programs, hearing conservation program, industrial hygiene, safety-related inspection and investigation, safety and environmental laws including OSHA, Texas Hazard Communication Act, RCRA, SARA Title III, Clean Air Act, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and hazardous waste handling
- Advanced skill in conducting investigations and required hearings
- Strong skills in Microsoft Office suite, Visio, Origami RMIS
- Ability to speak a language in addition to English is highly desirable

Desirable:

- Professional designation as a Certified Safety Professional (CSP), Certified Health Safety Professional (CHSP), Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH), Texas Field Safety certification or other equally recognized loss prevention certification
- One or more of the following industry certifications: Associate in Risk Management (ARM), Charter Property Casualty Underwriter (CPCU) or Certified Risk Management (CRM) or equivalent
- Subject Matter Expert in developing safety management programs, incident and claim program, RMIS implementation and management
- Knowledge of the contractual side of insurance (legal)

Special requirement:

This is defined as an employee whose attendance is required to maintain airport operations during an emergency or inclement weather situation.
